Code of Conduct

Purpose

- Be transparent about conflicts of interest and avoid any behaviour that could be perceived as self-serving.
- Fulfil responsibilities diligently and uphold commitments.

3. Confidentiality

 Respect the privacy of individuals and the confidentiality of personal or sensitive information.

4. Safety and Well-Being

- Promote a physically and emotionally safe environment for all.
- Report any harmful or unsafe behaviour or practices promptly to a trustee.
- Refrain from engaging in conduct that could impair judgement or put others at risk.

5. Professional Conduct

- Represent SARA positively in the community.
- Follow all applicable laws, organisational policies and health and safety guidelines.
- Use resources (financial, material or digital) responsibly and only for charity related purposes.

6. Conflict Resolution

- Address disagreements constructively and with respect.
- Seek to resolve conflicts amicably through dialogue.

7. Commitment to the Objects

- Support the charity's goals.
- Contribute time, effort and skills in ways that align with the organisation's objectives.
